CONSIGNOR ELIGIBILITY

- Must be a 2025 member of the Iowa Angus Association or Iowa Junior Angus Association in good standing without accounts receivable due.
- Consignor must be listed as first owner on the registration certificate.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Only registered Angus female entries of **5 years of age or younger** (on sale day) will be accepted.
- Any female meeting age requirement is eligible: **open, bred, or with calf at side.**
 - Bred females must be bred to registered Angus bulls.
 - May sell as a pen of 2 or 3 at consignors request.
- All entries must be **genomic tested** by time of entry.
- All potential carriers of genetic defects must be tested by Sale Check-In. If a defect is present, the animal will not be permitted to sell.
- Entry must be submitted online at www.iowaangus.org/iaa-sales by February 1, 2025 and include:
 - An original Angus registration certificate for each animal.
 - \$250 deposit per animal. This will be returned in full if animal goes through the sale
 - A footnote of reasonable length for use in the sale catalog. Sale manager reserves the right to edit as needed.
 - **Optional:** Consignors are encouraged to submit photos at entry time for use in the sale catalog. Sale management reserves the right to use or not use the photos in presale advertising.
- Consignor must offer to sell a minimum of one-half interest on the entry.
- Consignor will not be allowed to withdraw animals after entry deadline without forfeiting their deposit. If animal is checked in, it must sell unless an unforeseen accident occurs.

ARRIVAL AND CHECK-IN

- All sale entries will be expected to arrive on Saturday, March 29 from 12:00-8:00 pm.
- All sale entries will be expected to check-in on Saturday, March 29 from 6:00-8:00 pm.
 - Any animal with a tattoo that is not readable or inconsistent with that shown on the registration certificate at check-in will be ineligible to sell.
- Individual interstate health papers must be provided at check in.
- Substitutions will be allowed (one per consignor) provided the consignor supplies the original registration certificate and a current performance pedigree at check in time. **Advance notice of a substitution to the sale manager is strongly encouraged.**
- Once an animal is checked in it is not allowed to leave the grounds.

SALE PROCEDURE

- **SALE ORDER** will be determined by a combination of IAA board members, sale manager(s), AAA regional manager, auctioneer and unbiased parties named by the IAA Show and Sale Committee.
- Consignors wishing to floor their animals (minimum bid) must communicate that request with the auction staff.
- Sale expenses for stalling, bedding, advertising, auctioneer, ring service, etc. will be prorated on a per head basis. Iowa Angus Association commission will be assessed at 5% of consignor gross. This includes "no sales". These funds will be extracted from the sale proceeds, which will be dispersed in a timely manner.
- Direct payments from buyer to consignor will not be allowed. All sale proceeds must go through the Iowa Angus sale account
- Cattle scratched from the sale will forego the \$250 deposit. \$200 will go toward sale expense and \$50 for Iowa Angus commission.
